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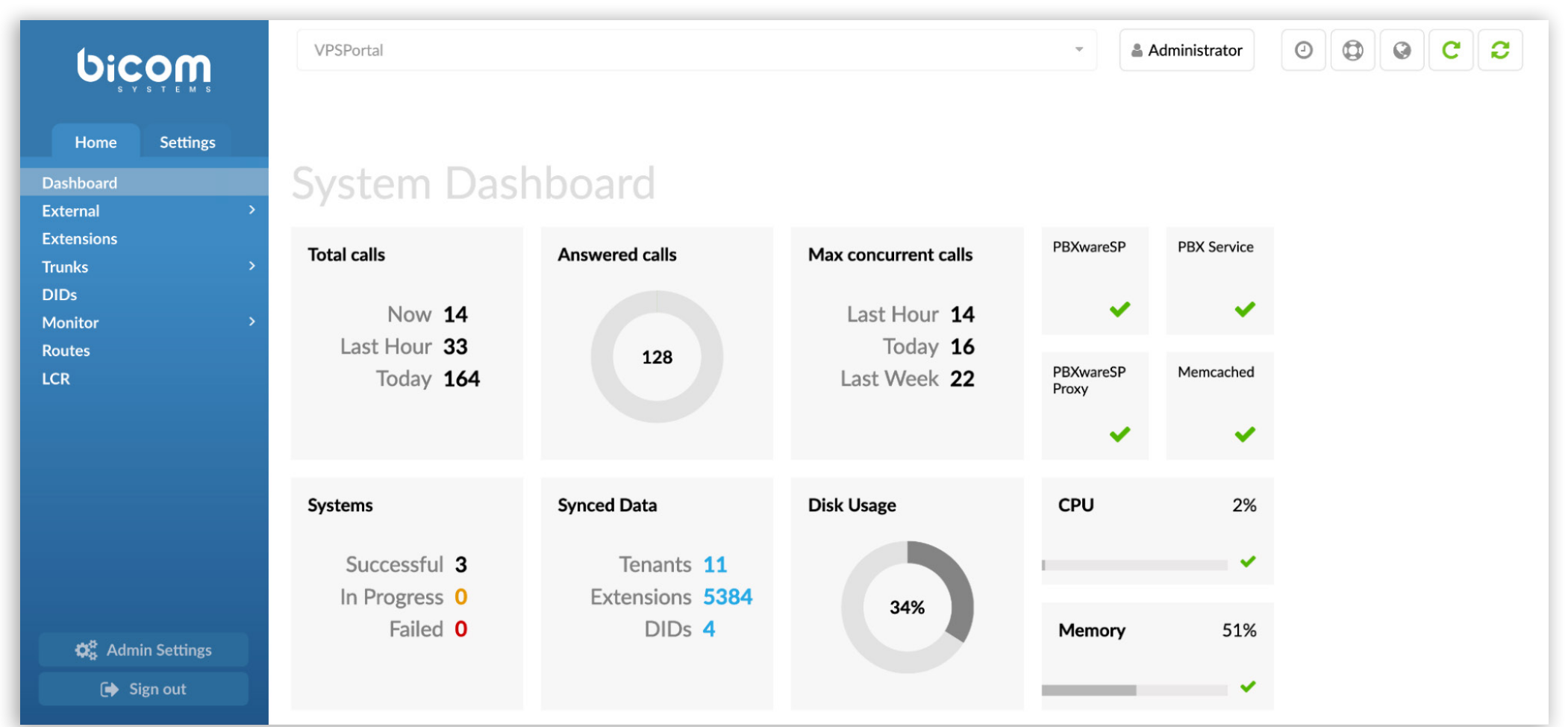
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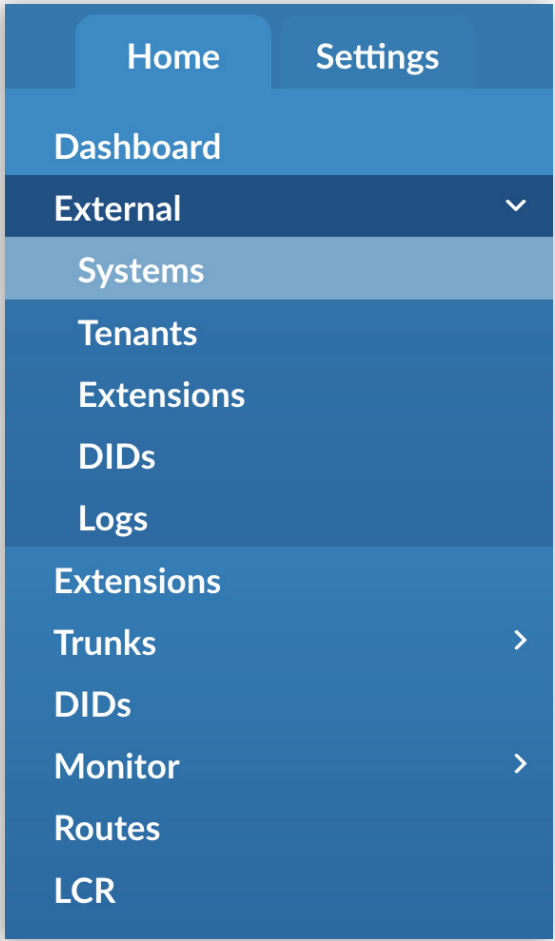
Features

PBXware SP Edition



From PBXware version 6.7, users will be able to utilize a completely new PBXware edition - SP (Service Provider) edition. PBXware SP was developed to make the management and access to data of multiple PBXware systems much easier by syncing all the key data (Extensions, DIDs, Tenants) from a remote system(s) to one central location.

The main advantage of PBXware SP is the ease of use and simplification of administration tasks performed across a number of PBXware systems. A centralized SP interface enables Administrators to edit Systems, Tenants, Extensions, and DID settings on external systems quickly, without having to log in to each system individually.

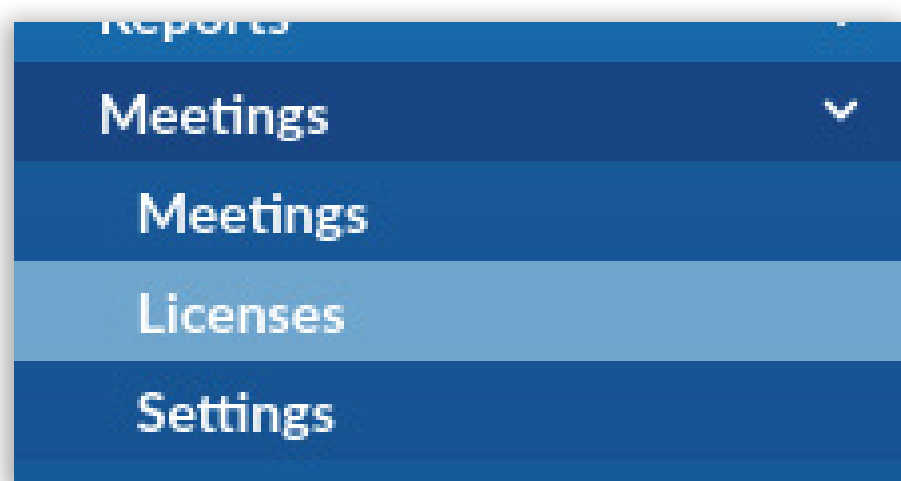


The new tab is added to the side menu bar - External, containing the following:

- **Systems** - displays all the servers that are currently added on PBXware SP Edition
- **Tenants** - displays the list of External Tenants
- **Extensions** - displays the list of External Extensions
- **DIDs** - displays the list of External DIDs
- **Logs** - displays the list of Logs related to operations performed during sync with external systems

If the optional feature named **Enable Auto-Setup for Call Routing** is enabled during the addition of a new external system, a trunk will be automatically created between SP and external PBXware, and all the DIDs from the external system will be re-created on SP, allowing you to use it as a class4 system.

Meeting Licensing



Administrators will be able to use the 'Licenses' section to assign Meeting licenses to specific Extensions. They will also be able to filter the data by entering specific Extensions or license packages: **No License**, **STARTER**, **BUSINESS**, or **ENTERPRISE**.

NOTE: From the 6.7 version, only the 'STARTER' and 'BUSINESS' packages will be available for use, while the 'ENTERPRISE' package will be implemented in the upcoming versions.

If the Administrator would like to assign new BUSINESS packages, he will need to navigate to the Meetings → Licenses section and simply click on the radio button in the BUSINESS column next to the Extensions to which he would like to assign the new BUSINESS licenses. Apart from the list of Extensions and licenses, users can refer to the information on the number of available and the number of assigned licenses, e.g., 3 of 10 (available 7).

v6.7 Meeting Licensing Change

Important notification for all Meeting module users

With the release of PBXware v6.7, all current Meeting users will be automatically assigned Starter packages for all the extensions on the tenant/system with a Meeting license regardless of whether they've upgraded to v6.7 or stayed on lower versions of PBXware.

In order to buy a bigger package, users will have to upgrade to v6.7 of PBXware.

With the update of our products to v6.7, there will be a new version of BRM for Meeting pricing, affecting all Meeting users regardless of the software version they are on.

All current Meeting users will be automatically assigned Starter packages for all the extensions in the tenant with a Meeting license.

This includes the following gloCOM editions: Business, CC, and Supervisor. Office edition doesn't have Meeting licenses.

So, all current Meeting users (regardless if they’ve upgraded to v6.7 or stayed on v6.6 and lower) will still have Meeting, it will be free but at a limited capacity (Starter limitation).

In order to buy a Business package, users will have to upgrade to v6.7 of PBXware.

The limitations of the Meeting packages are as follows:

gloCOM feature permissions per extension

In version 6.7, we are also introducing the ability to edit gloCOM Features permissions per extension, from Editions & Modules section.

Until now, these permissions could only be modified from the Apps → Permissions page, and this addition should provide a more streamlined user experience.

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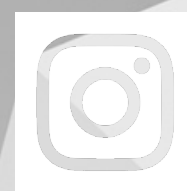
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
