



4 steps to protect your VoIP

While using VoIP, your phone system is like a Credit Card: you need to secure it.

1. USE PBXware SERVICE PLANS

- Limited Service Plan for your Local Market
- Limited International Service Plan

2. CREATING LIMITS

- Set a low Credit Limit for the master extension
- Enabled Limits, to Cap all international calls (e.g \$10)
- Only enable international calls for clients who request it
- Require a signed agreement/LD accepting the liability of international calls from their system

3. INTERNATIONAL PREFIX

- Change the default International Code from 011 (default) to 0201 (example)
- When possible Turn International OFF on the Carrier Side

4. THREAT DETECTION AND BLOCKING

- Choose VoIP platform that has integrated IP authentication (vs.username/PW)
- Enable granular call blocking to known problem rate centers/countries
- Turn on soft and hard-limit notifications to monitor spend daily
